- Install, construct, maintain, repair, and replace electrical components and related equipment on high voltage and low voltage systems;
- Provide technical guidance to contractors in regard to requirements for electrical installations;

- Conduct a variety of activities related to customer service in a positive and professional manner;
- Coordinate and interact with external agencies and authorities to organize and carry out work activities; and
- Obtain and retain all required licenses, and certificates required for this position.
